




Waste Disposal Responsibilities

This residence uses an on-site system to treat all its wastewater. This means it is not connected to a municipal sewer so extra care needs to be taken to ensure that the system operates properly. Following these recommended best practices will protect the health of the system.

	Problem	Consequence	Solutions
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> x Food Scraps x Fats, Oils and Greases 	These items are difficult for bacteria to break down. Tanks may require more pump outs. Grease can clog the system.	Don't use in-sink garbage disposals. Don't pour fats or oils down the drains. Scrape food off dishes before washing.
